#### New media regulations could hamper freedom of expression: Alice Wells

Washington: Chief US diplomat for South Asian affairs, Alice Wells, on Tuesday expressed concern over the Pakistan government's new social media rejulations, adding that they "could be a setback to freedom of expression and development of digital economy" faking to Twitter, she stated: "Unfortunate if Pakistan discourages foreign investors and affiles domestic innovation in such a dynamic sector. Encourage discussion with stakehold-arise?" On February 12, the federal cabinet had approved a set of rules to regulate social media in the country, under which social

information, traffic data or content data. Under the rules, social media platforms will be required to remove any unlawful content pointed out to them in writing or electronically signed email within 24 hours, and in emergency cases within as hours. However, the long-running negotiation a durable peace. However, the long-running negotiations between the US and Tailiban have yet to achieve the ideal results, though at times it has appeared that both parties have been tantalisingly close to an agreement. On Tuesday, a Tailiban spokesman accused the Americans of stalling the peace process and 'blame-shifting'. The statement appears to be a reaction to the US secretary of state's recent comments that the Taliban must reduce violence in order for the peace process to move for-ward. The statements from both sides may well be public posturing to put pressure on the other and achieve maximum gains behind closed doors. After all, US officials recently visited Afghanistan and Pakistan to brief both states on the status of the negotiations. Indeed, the Taliban need to shun violence, especially the targeting of noncombatants. to send a signal to all concerned that they are serious about peace. However, the US must also realise that there is a small window of opportunity here, and if the Taliban are rebuffed they must shun the peace process altogether and return to the battlefield for the long run. ## World Bank delays two of Pakistan's budgetary support loans

ISLAMABAD. The World Bank has delayed the approval of two budgetary support loans worth \$750 million due to lack of progress on some of the agreed prior conditions, including disagreement among provinces over harmonisation of the general sales tax (GST) one services. The postponement would also delay the restoration of Pakistan's budgetary support, which had been suspended four years ago owing to the deterioration of macroeconomic indicators. Last time, the Washington-based lender had approved a budgetary support loan
