Shahab Ahmed Khan, have expressed disappointment over a meager reduction of just one percent in Policy Rate by the State Bank of Pakistan, terming it 'too little, too late'.

They stated that for a long time even before the pandemic, KCCI has consistently demanded to bring the policy rate to down to 4% in one go rather than in installments. Reduction in policy rate in bits and pieces did not provide the much needed thrust to economy whereas a one-conomy whereas a economy whereas a one-time major reduction to 4% could have triggered growth could have triggered growth and accelerated economic activities. Reduction in policy rate in bits and pieces is not enough to provide stimulus to the economy hence, it is necessary to significantly reduce the interest rate in a single step, to rescue the trade and industry which is going through an unprecedented crisis. Revision in policy rate to 7% will effectively mean the interest rate for large scale borrowers will be 8% to 9% after adding the bank's spread while it will not be less than 10% to 12% for smaller entities.
